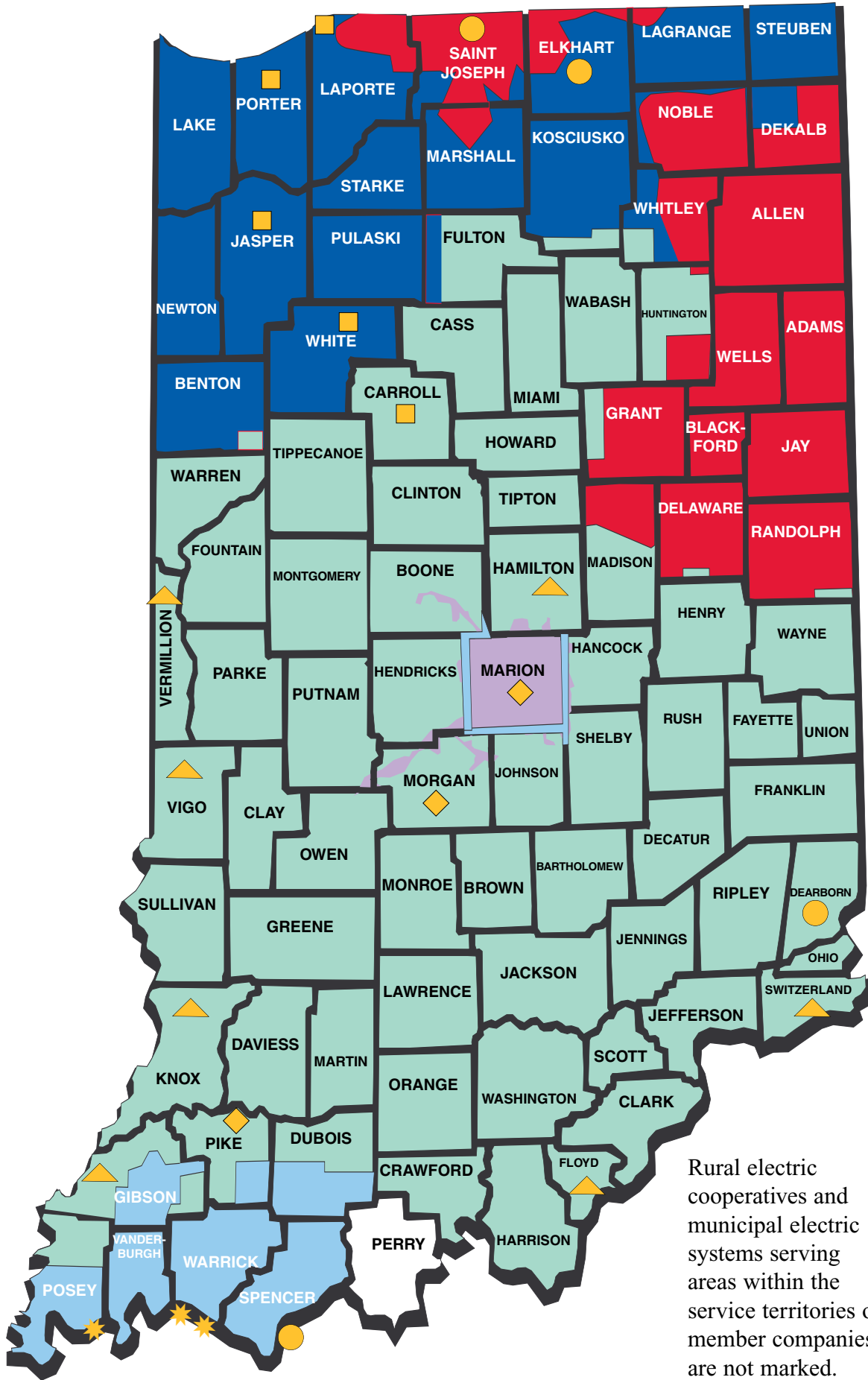

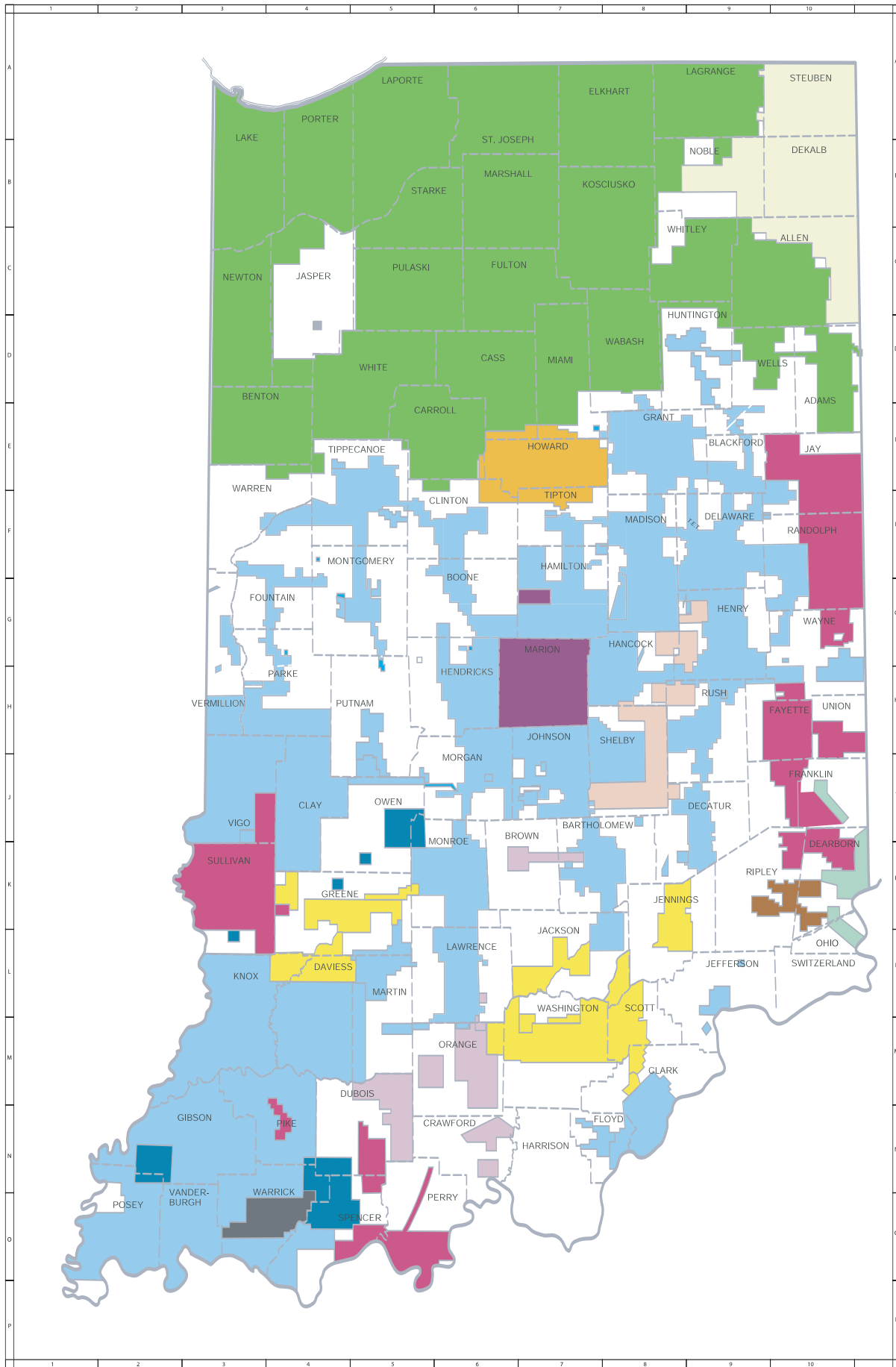

In 2004 - 2005, these companies:

- Provided over 1.8 million Hoosier gas customers with the 17th lowest gas rates in the country.
- Contributed \$1,000,000 to the Help Thy Neighbor program to help Hoosiers in need pay their utility bills.
- Paid over \$400 million in corporate income tax to the State of Indiana and property taxes to local governments.
- Engaged in gas purchasing practices to keep natural gas commodity costs as low as possible; costs passed on to consumers without profit to the utility.
- Provided over \$17,500,000 a year in low income funding and weatherization assistance.
- Encouraged customer conservation, weatherization and enrollment in budget billing to spread the cost of winter heating throughout the year.
